

# CHS iPad Classroom Rules

- 1. When the class begins (at the bell) all iPads are to be closed and placed face-down on or under students' desks or placed in a designated spot in the classroom. iPads are not to be opened or used unless directed to do so by the classroom teacher.**
- 2. While the teacher is actively teaching and iPads are being used, all iPads are to be placed flat on the student desk. Student iPad screens are to be visible to the teacher at all times.**
- 3. The following electronic activities are NOT allowed during instruction or student work time, unless the classroom teacher gives explicit permission:**
  - a. Gaming**
  - b. Social networking**
  - c. Messaging**
  - d. email**
  - e. Recording of sound, pictures or video**
  - f. Personal, undirected browsing or searching**
  - g. Using headphones and/or listening to music**
- 4. Students are NOT allowed to record AT ANY TIME audio, photos, or video of other students or staff without their explicit permission.**

**Any violation of the above rules, additional teacher classroom iPad rules, or the Responsible Use Agreement (RUA) may result in the teacher confiscating the student's iPad. The iPad may only be returned to the student by Mr. Beckenhauer, or a staff member designated by him.**

The following guidelines will be used to determine the consequences for violations of the these rules:

- First offense - Student will be required to attend the next STOPiT class.
- Second offense - Student loses casual use (take-home and free-time) privileges for one week, and is required to attend the next STOPiT class.
- Third offense - Student loses casual use (take-home and free-time) privileges for two weeks, and is required to attend the next STOPiT class.
- Fourth offense - Student loses casual use (take-home and free-time) privileges for the remainder of the school year, and is required to attend the next STOPiT

class.
